An example of a Gathering Statement

We gather to wonder at the mystery which is God

Monthly

After the Gatherings on each Sunday there is an activity or event with which people can choose to be involved:

1st Sunday of the month – Community Lunch

Communion is served on the 1st Sunday of the month in the Gathering. After the service, on the even months (Feb, April, June, August, October and December) we hold a community lunch in the Hall to which people bring plates of food to share. (Food which can be eaten in the fingers is best) On the odd numbered months, a variable group of people lunch together at a nearby cafe which is chosen on the day. Listen for the announcement.

2nd Sunday of the month – Congregational Conversation

After church, a circle of chairs is formed at the front of the church and an informal conversation is chaired by the Convenor of the Parish Council and/or the Minister. This can be about items brought by the Parish Council for information or concerns people have. All welcome to this conversation.

3rd Sunday of the month – Social Justice

A group meets in the Centre around issues of Social Justice. These include the environment, political submissions which are current, (e.g. for including the Social Security Amendment Bill and TPPA), signage for bathrooms, etc.

4th Sunday of the month – Exploring the Faith

A group meets in the Centre to study recent progressive scholarship such as the DVD series 'Living the Questions', (multiple questions of faith), 'Eclipsing Empire' (Jesus and Paul). Mostly led by the minister at present.

5th Sunday – free!

Nothing specific is planned whenever there is a 5th Sunday in the month!

Other monthly events:

Spirited Conversations - Pam Fuller

Meets May-October, the fourth Tuesday night of the month in St Andrew's Centre. Usually an inexpensive catered meal with speaker and discussion.
6.15pm for the meal, 7-9pm for the programme.

A group meets at 10.30am to get a cuppa and then we have a group 'round' or 'check in' from 11-12 noon each Wednesday in the Centre.

Centering Prayer

A group meets for meditation at 12.30pm each Thursday in the Centre.

Worship Committee

Oversees worship in consultation with the minister. About 3-4 times a year a group meets to coordinate special services with lay involvement for Advent/St Andrew's Day, Lent/Easter, Pentecost and Creation

Pastoral Committee

A small group meets to coordinate the parish rolls and the Pastoral Partners network (see separate leaflet for more information on this network)
